Because of the surge in infection of Covid-19, a state of emergency was declared in Hokkaido starting on May 16th. Accordingly, the BCP of Hokkaido University was raised, and it is currently at Level 3. We take the following measures to prevent the spread of infection on campus as well as from commuting to the campus.

1. In School of Economics (both graduate and undergraduate programs), ALL classes to be held ON-LINE, NOT on a face-to-face basis. For those courses scheduled to have face-to-face class, the instructors will notify you of specific class dates from which the class will shift online.
